Dear President Sprouls:

Congratulations! Your interior design program leading to Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design has been awarded continued accreditation for the remainder of the six-year term, originally effective in August 2019.

Award of CIDA accreditation attests to the quality of your interior design program and benefits your program in many ways. Parents, students, and employers of graduates can be assured that your program meets the rigor of peer review and develops the skills and knowledge required to practice interior design. Furthermore, the accreditation process provides your program with valuable input for continued development and assists the program in adapting to meet evolving professional requirements as CIDA updates Standards.

In October 2021, the Accreditation Commission extended the scope of CIDA accreditation for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree at the New York School of Interior Design to include an online delivery method. The purpose of the interim review was to evaluate the new online delivery method and its compliance with CIDA Standards 1-3. The interim review also included expectations that were marked below the required level of achievement the program's August 2019 Accreditation Report. The Interim Report includes detailed comments related to program compliance and is accompanied by the New York School of Interior Design Progress Report, which serves as an important reference for understanding the evaluation presented in the Interim Report.

The program should be revisited in **fall 2025** to seek re-accreditation.

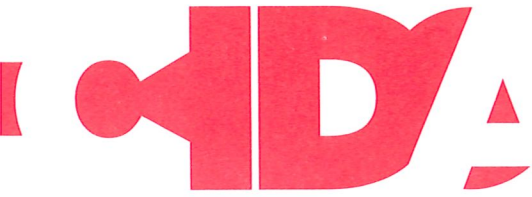
